

**Term Limits**

Looking through the committee membership appointments, I have been able to establish the following:

In March of 1999, staggered term limits were established for current members. For members serving at that time, that are still serving on the committee, terms were established with the following end dates:

Term ending 12/31/99

Term ending 12/31/00

Ted Smith

Since the establishment of those terms:

- David Nelson was appointed in 1999 with a term to expire 12/31/2001
- Frank Racek was appointed 5/04 to a term expiring 12/31/06
- Sally Holewa was appointed 5/04 to a term expiring 12/31/06

Dale Sandstrom, Penny Miller, Joel Medd and Becky Absey were reappointed to terms ending in December of 2002, 2005 and 2008. In accordance with the term limit rule, these four individuals will be ineligible to be reappointed in 2008.

Ted Smith and Allan Schmalenberger were reappointed to terms ending in December of 2003 and 2006. In accordance with the term limit rule, these two individuals will be ineligible to be reappointed in 2006.

David Nelson was reappointed to terms ending in December of 2001, 2004 and 2007. In accordance with the term limit rule, David Nelson will be ineligible to be reappointed in 2007.

Sally Holewa and Frank Racek are serving their first term each. They can be reappointed to two more terms, ending in December 2009 and 2012.
