

The courts use both digital and analog recording systems.

Analog

The courts use Sony and Lanier analog recorders with a 4-track player. Cassettes are recorded at a 1.2 or 2.4 tape speed.

Transcribing equipment must be compatible with both Sony and Lanier equipment and able to isolate 4 channels, individually.

Digital

The courts use recording software and equipment from Voice IQ to record proceedings. A limited version of Voice IQ transcribing software is available as a free download from Voice IQ. The full version of the software can be purchased from Voice IQ at www.VIQSolutions.com.
