The vehicle was spotted by a Clay County deputy at a boat landing on the Convent Landing around 52nd Avenue South on the North Dakota side of the river.

Police look for driver from high-speed chase

MOORHEAD - Police are looking for a 53-year-old suspect following a 100-mph chase Tuesday night.
