Racek, Judge of the district court, East Central Judicial District, to hold an evidentiary hearing and make findings of fact on the following issue: whether Terry B. - [¶3] IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, Judge Racek hold the hearing and submit findings of fact no later than 1:30 p.m. Thursday, September 24, 2020. The hearing may be held through the use of reliable electronic means.
