

## Judicial Branch Education Commission

### Accreditation of Faculty Participation

Under Administrative Rule 36, the following applies toward accreditation of faculty participation.

A judge who serves on the faculty of an approved judicial education or continuing legal education course is entitled to claim as judicial education hours an amount of time equal to the actual presentation and up to two times the presentation time for preparation. A judge who serves on a panel may claim the entire time of the panel presentation as presentation time.

A judge claiming judicial education hours for faculty participation shall list those hours on the Report of Compliance report provided to the judge or by separate affidavit. A judge may claim only fifteen (15) judicial education hours for faculty participation in any one reporting period. A municipal judge may claim only six (6) judicial education hours for faculty participation in any one reporting period.
