### **Age & Number of Members in the County Bar**

- There are 3 attorneys who practice in Rolla, ND which is located within Rolette County. The attorneys are aged 79, 64, and 29.
  - The 29-year-old is Attorney Mickelson Hendrickson who is the Attorney Rolette County has agreed to partner with for the Rural Attorney Recruitment Program.
- There is 1 attorney who practices in Belcourt, ND which is located within Rolette County. The attorney is aged 69.
- There is 1 attorney who practices part time in Rolla, ND but has its primary practice located in Towner County. The attorney is aged 37.

### **Economic Development Programs Within Rolette County**

- Rolette County as a whole does not have a county economic development program but many towns within the County have economic development programs that strengthen their individual cities and the county as a whole.
  - **Dunseith**
    - The Community Development Corporation of Dunseith has been busy since 1968 being involved in many business and community projects. These activities include the development of the Dunseith Community Nursing Home, Drug Store Building, Insurance Office, and Beauty Shop. They have also been involved in relocation of houses into Dunseith to assist with the heavy demand for low rent and home ownership housing.
  - **Belcourt**
    - Representatives from the Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Indians have implemented a comprehensive 10-year Economic Development Expansion Master Plan in the Turtle Mountain region. The Master Plan has facilitated the recent

and anticipated opening of several new projects and businesses. These include Turtle Island Adventure Park; Sky Jump Trampoline Park; Winter Activities Park; Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Indians food distribution center; and a New Career and Technical Education center.

o **Rolla**

- The Rolla Job Development Authority was founded in 1989 and has helped build and grow the community through programs such as the Bank of ND's Flex/Pace Program, state grants, and sheer determination and love of the community. The Rolla JDA's most notable accomplishments as of recent are they created/built: a main street park with business incubators, a walking/hiking/cross country ski path, a program for high school seniors that allows students the opportunity to work and explore careers every afternoon, continued longevity of established Rolla businesses through sales to the next generation, and new businesses and services that are filling Rolla's Main Street.

**Prior Participation in the Program by Rolette County**

- Rolette County has not previously participated in the Rural Attorney Recruitment Program.

**Rolette County's Commitment to Pay 35% of Incentive Payment**

- Rolette County agrees to provide 35% of the \$45,000.00 incentive payment, to be paid in five annual equal installments.
- The 2024 Rolette County Budget includes the yearly \$3,150.00.

**Agreement with Attorney Mickelson Hendrickson**

- Please see the attached Memorandum of Understanding between the Rolette County State's Attorney's Office and Attorney Rachael Mickelson Hendrickson where Attorney Mickelson-Hendrickson promises to provide assistance to the Rolette County State's Attorney in exchange for Rolette County partnering with Attorney Mickelson Hendrickson in the Rural Attorney Recruitment Program.

**Explanation of Rolette County's Need for an Attorney**

- Several of the members of the County bar are in the process of retiring. With a predominately young population, it is important to attract an attorney to the area. There are endless opportunities for an attorney from helping individuals start new businesses, completing real estate transactions, working with the local banks on trusts and loans, prosecution, defense, etc. With local cities working hard to advance their towns, it is important that Rolette County has a local attorney who individuals know, can easily access, and can help support the

development. If Rolette County is without an attorney, individuals will have to travel a significant distance to obtain services. Individuals residing in Rolette County still appreciate a face-to-face meeting and many in the community are wary of technology or technology is not accessible to them. A local attorney solves those problems. We want our county to continue to advance and having a local attorney would help us reach our goal.

Memorandum of Understanding  
Rachael Mickelson-Hendrickson, Attorney at Law and Rolette County State's  
Attorney's Office

Purpose: Pursuant to a potential grant available and designed for recruitment and retention of rural attorneys, which is being sought through the efforts of Attorney Mickelson-Hendrickson, successful application and receiving the grant will trigger the following obligations.

The parties stipulate and agree:

1. The prospective grant is for a term of five (5) years starting January 1, 2024, or at whatever time the grant funds are available. Rolette County is responsible for a match/share of the grant in the amount of \$15,750.00. Of that match Rolette County is responsible for \$3150.00 annually;
2. Attorney Mickelson-Hendrickson is to provide sixty (60) hours service annually, for the term of the grant; The assignments are at the discretion of the Rolette County State's Attorney. Attorney Mickelson-Hendrickson is allowed to reject an assignment. Documentation of time to be maintained by Attorney Mickelson-Hendrickson.
3. Attorney Mickelson-Hendrickson is to maintain malpractice insurance during the pendency of the grant.
4. Early termination of this memorandum of understanding is permissible for reasonable casue. Examples of reasonable casue would include Attorney Mickelson Hendrickson no longer practicing, or an unforeseen conflict of interest. If possible, thirty (30) days notice of termination is preferred.
5. The parties are free to negotiate mutually agreed changes in the memorandum of understanding, so long as the changes do not violate the requirements of the grant.
6. Attorney Mickelson Hendrickson agrees to locate her residence and practice within Rolette County for the duration of this agreement.
7. If Attorney Mickelson Hendrickson breaches this agreement, she shall repay all funds received under this agreement.

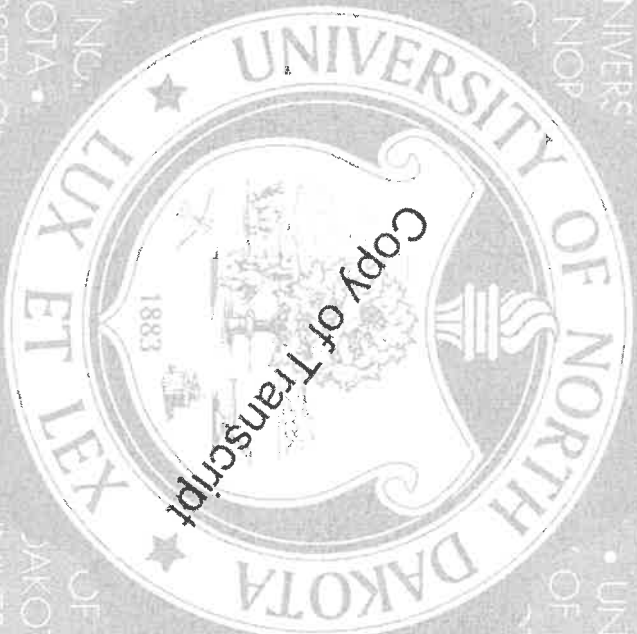


