written report containing the Guardian Ad Litem's response to the petition and an

assessment of the ability of the alleged child becoming an incapacitated individual

to attend the hearing either in-person or by remote means.

6. The court will determine who will be responsible for the costs of the Guardian ad

Litem's services.

7. The Guardian ad Litem shall have access to the legal, financial, and medical records,

including psychiatric, mental health, psychological, and chemical dependence records, of the

alleged child becoming an incapacitated individual.
