

Information Related to Continuation of a Guardianship or Conservatorship

Forms available on the ND Legal Self Help webpage **aren't** official forms. Judges and courts aren't required to accept them. There's no guarantee Center forms will be accepted.

Use at your own risk!

Don't include these information sheets when you serve or file the completed form.

This form is normally sent out by the court to Guardians and Conservators to complete **prior** to a Continuation Review Hearing. While the court only mails these to selected parties, [North Dakota law](#) requires the court to consider information provided by **any party** with an interest in the case.

Caption:

The top of the form is called the Caption. Use the most recent order or annual report filed by the Guardian to fill in the caption.

If you can't locate the information, you may call the [clerk of court](#) for the county where the case is filed to find the district name and court case number.

Questions 1-4:

Print or type your name, contact information, and the Ward's address. If you don't, the court may not accept your form.

Questions 5-7:

If you **aren't** the Guardian or Conservator, cross out Questions 5, 6, and 7.

If **you've been appointed** as Guardian or Conservator, answer the questions to the best of your ability.

Question 8:

Add comments with the information you'd like to share with the court. Be thorough and attach more pages if needed.

- a) If you aren't the Guardian, explain your relationship to the Ward.
- b) If it isn't self-explanatory, describe how you became aware of the issues you're sharing with the court.
- c) If the Ward asked you to relay information on their behalf, please note that in the comments.

Question 9:

This section is primarily for the Guardian and Conservator to update the court with contact information for interested parties. If you know of other people who should receive information about the Ward, note those people here.

Question 10:

You must sign and date the form. Courts can't accept unsigned forms or letters.

After you complete the form, mail or deliver the original document to the clerk of court for the county where the case is filed.
