- 5. The minor child has the right to retain an attorney to represent them and present their point of view about whether a conservator/co-conservators should be appointed and who should be appointed.
- 6. You MUST be present at the hearing and prepared to participate and present evidence of what you what. You may ask questions of the Petitioner's witnesses and call your own witnesses. The Court may excuse your attendance at the hearing for good cause.
- 7. If the Court finds the minor child is in need of a conservator/co-conservators, the Court will consider whether the person(s) proposed to be the conservator/co-conservators should be appointed. The Court will also consider whether some other qualified person(s) should be appointed as the conservator/co-conservators. The Court will also determine whether there should be any limits on the powers and duties of the conservator/co-conservators.
