# PROVISIONAL ORDER GRANTING/GENVING PETITION TO TRANSFER GUARDIANSHIP/GCONSERVATORSHIP TO ANOTHER STATE

#### THE COURT FINDS:

1. A petition has been filed seeking transfer of this **Q**guardianship/ conservatorship from

North Dakota to \_\_\_\_\_(County and State).

2. Notice of this petition was given to those persons who would be entitled to notice of a

petition in this state for the appointment of a  $\Box$ guardian/ $\Box$ conservator.

3. There has not been an objection to the transfer.

There has been an objection to the transfer. The objector Thas/Thas not established

that the transfer would be contrary to the interests of the ward/protected person.

4. The court:

is satisfied that the court of the other state is likely to accept jurisdiction.

OR

is not satisfied that the court of the other state is likely to accept jurisdiction.

#### 5. The ward/protected person:

## THEREFORE, THE COURT ORDERS:

- 8. The Petition to Transfer North Dakota Guardianship/Conservatorship:
  - a. Dis provisionally granted.
    - 1) The □guardian/co-guardians □conservator/co-conservators shall petition for acceptance of □guardianship/□conservatorship jurisdiction in the other state.
    - 2) After the other state issues a provisional order accepting transfer of

jurisdiction of the guardianship/Gconservatorship, the guardian/co-

guardians/ conservator/co-conservators shall move this Court for a final

order confirming the transfer of jurisdiction and terminating the

guardianship/ Conservatorship.

OR

b. Dis denied and dismissed without prejudice.
