The state hospital or public treatment facility must immediately accept, if appropriately screened and medically stable, and a private treatment facility may accept, the respondent on a provisional basis. The designated professional, within 24 hours, shall file a notice with the Court stating the circumstances and factors of the case. The Court shall, after a hearing within 48 hours of receipt of the notice and based upon the evidence presented, modify this Order.
