## Instructions for Declaration of Petitioner: Criminal History Records Checks of the Minor Child and/or Objections

ND Legal Self Help Center Staff and Court employees can't help you fill out forms, or create documents for you. If you're unsure how to proceed, consult a lawyer.

ND Legal Self Help Forms aren't official forms. Judges and courts aren't required to accept them. There's no guarantee Center forms will be accepted. Use at your own risk.

Don't include these instruction sheets when you serve or file the completed form.

A Declaration is a written statement of fact given by an individual with first-hand knowledge of the facts.

As of March 1, 2018, **in general**, **notarization isn't required** when a Declaration will be filed in a civil case with a North Dakota state district court.

The Declaration of Petitioner: Criminal History Records Checks of the Minor Child and/or Objections is used when you're notified by the court in the child's name change case that you:

- 1. **Must** obtain a criminal history records check of the minor child; **And/Or**
- 2. **Must** wait 30 calendar days from the date of publication of the Notice of Petition for Name Change of the minor child at which time you **must** file an Affidavit or Declaration stating whether you received any objections to the notice of name change of the child.
- Fill in the caption with the same information that you filled in all of the other name change documents.
- □ 1. Fill in the date of the notice from the Court.
  - $\Box$  Put a checkmark ( $\checkmark$ ) in the box(es) indicating what the Court told you to do.
- □ 2. Criminal History Records Check. Put a checkmark (✓) in the correct box. If you submitted a request for a criminal history records check of the minor child, fill in the date you submitted this request.
  - □ If you checked the second box indicating you submitted a request, check the box indicating whether: (1) you received the criminal records check and are filing it with the court, **or** (2) you would like the Court to keep your case open until you receive the criminal history records check and can file it with the court.

- □ 3. Objections Within 30 Calendar Days After Publication Date. Put a checkmark (✓) in the correct box.
  - If you checked the second box, fill in the date the Notice of Petition for Name Change was published, the name of the newspaper, and the county the newspaper is located.
  - □ Then, put a checkmark (✓) in the correct box. If you received written objections, list each objector's name and relationship to you and the child. You must attach the original of each objection you received to the Declaration. Make a copy of each objection for your records.
- □ 4. Date and Signature. You're stating that you declare under penalty of perjury under the law of North Dakota that everything you stated in this Declaration is true and correct.
  - Fill in the date, city, county, state, and country where your signed the Declaration.
  - Sign on the signature line.
  - Print your name.
  - Fill in the address lines. (If you have a physical address **and** a mailing address, type or write both addresses using the lines provided, and the space next to the address lines.)
  - Fill in your phone number **and** email address.
- □ Make a copy for your records.
- □ File the original with the clerk of court of the North Dakota county where the minor child's name change case is filed.
