## **Satisfaction of Judgment Process**

**For the Winning Party**: Any winning party in a District Court civil case can file a Satisfaction of Judgment and proof of service on each losing party with the District Court that ordered the judgment.

Information and requirements about satisfaction of judgment are found in <u>North Dakota</u> Century Code Section 28-30-24.

- 1. When the District Court judgment is satisfied, the winning party fills out the Satisfaction of Judgment. (The judgment may be settled for less than the amount ordered in the District Court's judgment.)
  - Fill out the top of the Satisfaction of Judgment the same as the top of the Summons;
     and
  - The winning party signs in front of a notary public or clerk of court.
- **2.** The winning party **must serve** a copy of the completed Satisfaction of Judgment on **each** losing party in the District Court case.
  - Make a copy for yourself and once copy for each losing party.
  - Put the copy for each losing party in a separate envelope addressed to the losing party.
  - An individual who is 18 years or older mails each envelope by United States first-class mail. Postage must be prepaid.
  - The person who mailed the documents must fill out a Declaration of Service by Mail for each losing party and sign the Declaration, including their address, phone number, and email. \*\*\*If mailed from a United States Post Office, the Post Office employee doesn't complete a Declaration of Service by Mail.\*\*\*
- **3.** After mailing a copy of the Satisfaction of Judgment to **each** losing party and getting a completed, dated and signed Declaration of Service by Mail form that shows **each** losing party was served with a copy of the Satisfaction of Judgment, file the original Satisfaction of Judgment and Declaration(s) of Service by Mail with the clerk of court.

For information about how the court accepts documents for filing, contact the <u>clerk of court</u> of the District Court that ordered the judgment.
