- If you're applying for permission to start new litigation, file with the court in the district where you plan to file the new case. A new case number will be assigned if the filing is granted. This application form must be filed separately from the documents you're requesting to file.
- If you E-File, file this application separately from the documents you're requesting to file. The application will be filed and docketed, if it meets the requirements for E-Filing. When you submit the documents you're requesting to file, they're printed and put into a separate file for the judge to review. Then, the documents you're requesting to E-File are rejected with a note that they won't be filed until your application is granted.

After your application is filed, a judge of the court may allow you to file your new documents, or file a new case, ONLY IF it appears that your document(s) or new case have merit and aren't being filed for the purpose of harassment or delay.
