- Self-represented parties who have been declared vexatious litigants won't be permitted to
 file documents electronically and won't be provided a user ID and password to access the

After your application is filed, a judge of the court may allow you to file your new documents, or file a new case, only if it appears that your document(s) or new case have merit and aren't being filed for the purpose of harassment or delay.
