North Dakota House and Senate Journals – Quick Guide to Locating Discussions on Legislative Bills

Legislative History includes the following resources:

- Legislative committee minutes and testimony
- North Dakota House and Senate Journals
- North Dakota Session Laws

Please note that:

- * There are no legislative committee minutes or testimony available before 1959
- * Some early legislative history is pretty scarce
- * Most early legislative history is only available on microfiche

The legislative history for the years between 1959 and 1977 are on microfiche, and on separate sets of microfiche by House/Committee and Senate/Committee

- * To locate bills in the House and Senate Journals:
 - Find the Record of Senate Bills & Record of House Bills in the Journals (note: the wording for these sections might slightly differ)
 - o Find the Bill Number
 - Under the Bill Number there will be pages in the Journal where actions were taken on that Bill
 - If it is a House Bill, you will need to locate the Bill in both the House and Senate Journals
 - If it is a Senate Bill, you will need to locate the Bill in both the House and Senate Journals
- The legislative history for the years 1977 through 2009 are on microfiche by bill number
- ➤ The legislative history for legislative sessions after 2009 are on the Legislative Council's website. Some legislative history for previous years can also be located on the Legislative Council's website
