WITNESS FEES AND EXPENSES-STATE EMPLOYEES

When non-judicial personnel employed by the State of North Dakota are called as witnesses in any district court proceeding as a result of matters arising out of official duties, they are deemed to be performing duties and services for the State of North Dakota and as such shall not be provided witness fees nor be reimbursed for travel, subsistence, and room by the Judicial Branch.

It is presumed that State of North Dakota employees will be reimbursed for travel expenses to appear as witnesses by their employing agency, notwithstanding the fact that such employees could be appearing as witnesses during their off duty time.
