DISTRICT COURT JUDGE SERVICE AWARDS

- A. A judge who leaves office in good standing may be recognized for his or her service to the public.
- B. A judge who has not been previously recognized for his or her service, may be recognized as follows:
 - 1. An engraved plaque or an equivalent recognition, not to exceed \$100, to be presented on behalf of the Judicial Conference; and
 - 2. A gift with a value not to exceed \$200; and
 - 3. A public farewell coffee party, provided that the judge agrees to participate.
- C. Up to \$200 will be allowed for party expenses.
- D. Awards are provided as specified above and may not be combined or substituted for cash. Gift cards are taxable.
- E. A judge who is removed from office for misconduct is not eligible for a service award.
