The North Dakota Court System has issued a Request for Proposals for the analysis of the IT infrastructure used by North Dakota Courts to identify vulnerabilities and develop a plan for comprehensive disaster recovery. The analysis will be required to capture stakeholder requirements, measure strengths and weaknesses of the current back-up and recovery system utilized by the court system and develop recommendations for minimizing the risk of system disruption and data loss due to natural or manmade disaster.

All vendor communications related to this RFP and all proposals must be submitted to the State Court Administrator at the address listed in the RFP. The deadline to submit a proposal in response to the RFP is <u>4:30 p.m. central time, September 18, 2013.</u>

The expected completion date of the project is April 30, 2014.

Vendors should note that this RFP is being issued by a governmental entity. All contents of proposals, including the cost proposal and final contract for the project, become publicly accessible documents once the bid has been awarded. Any vendor requesting that access to proprietary information be restricted must make the request in a letter submitted separately from their proposal. The letter must describe the type of information to be restricted and the business reason restriction is desired. Vendors will be notified if their request to restrict information is denied and will be given an opportunity to withdraw or modify their proposal.
