


**ORDER RESCINDING JANUARY 11, 2022 STANDING ORDER
REGARDING RELIABLE ELECTRONIC MEANS HEARINGS AS OF MARCH 1, 2022**

[¶1] Given the downward trend over the past weeks of active COVID-19 cases in Rolette County, it is the Order of this Court that the Standing Order of January 11, 2022, requiring all Rolette County hearings to be held by reliable electronic means, shall expire as of March 1, 2022. From and after March 1, 2022, Rolette County court proceedings will return to in-person appearances, with reliable electronic means appearances still utilized as authorized by the Court.

[¶2] In a continuing effort to protect the public as well as participants in Court proceedings, from and after March 1, 2022 individuals are encouraged to maintain space between each other when possible, and mask use will continue to be encouraged, but not required.
