ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-3 - AMENDMENT TO SUSPENDED JURY TRIALS

[1] A State of Emergency was declared by Governor Doug Burgum on March 13, 2020 in

response to the global COVID-19 pandemic. The number of COVID-19 cases in North Dakota

sharply rose during the months of October and November, 2020.

[2] As a result, Governor Burgum ordered the State of North Dakota to condition orange. The

courthouses in the Southwest Judicial District remain either closed to the public, have jury trial

restriction in effect for their buildings, or have limited conditions under which people can enter

the courthouse.

[3] In response to the above referenced factors, this Court did enter an Order on November 24<sup>th</sup>,

2020 that provided for suspension of all jury trials in the Southwest Judicial District until further

notice. In the order, the Court did notice all affected that there would be a minimum of a two

week notice as to when trials shall resume.

[4] The Court has continued to monitor the situation and based upon the information that was

provided to the Court and after consultation with the judges of the Southwest Judicial District,

the Court amends its November 24th, 2020, Order and does hereby suspend jury trials in the

Southwest Judicial District until February 1, 2021. Any other hearing associated with the jury

trial, including but not limited to pre-trials shall remain as scheduled.
