Instructions for Form OP2: Declaration in Support of Answer Brief in Opposition to Motion for Default Judgment (*Debt Collection*)

(Form OP2:Declaration in Support of Answer Brief is part of the Answer to Motion for Default Divorce Judgment (Debt Collection) form set).

To Answer a Motion for Default Judgment in a debt collection action, the following forms are required:

- → OP2: Declaration in Support of Answer Brief in Opposition to Motion for Default Judgment (*Debt Collection*);
- ◆ Answer Debt Collection (if you already served an Answer to the Summons and Complaint, you don't fill out, copy, or serve this form);
- ◆ OP3: Confidential Information Form (*Debt Collection*);
- OP4: Declaration of Service by Mail (Debt Collection).

A Declaration in Support of Answer Brief is one of a set of required documents that make up a written Answer to Motion for Default Judgment (*Debt Collection*).

Form OP2: Declaration in Support of Answer Brief in Opposition to Motion for Default Judgment (*Debt* Collection) is your, the Defendant's, written statement of your facts that support what you wrote in your Answer Brief.

You, the Defendant, arrange to serve your Declaration in Support of Answer Brief in Opposition to Motion for Default Judgment (*Debt* Collection) with all of the other documents listed above.
