# Instructions for Form 4: Declaration of Default, Identification and Active Military Service

(Form MP4: Declaration of Default, Identification and Active Military Service is part of the Motion for Default Divorce Judgment. Review the instructions for the packet of forms.)

A Declaration of Default, Identification and Active Military Service is one of a set of required documents that make up a written Motion for Default Divorce Judgment.

The MP4: Declaration of Default, Identification and Active Military Service form is your, the Plaintiff's, written statement of the Defendant's default in answering the Summons and Complaint, the Defendant's address and occupation, and the Defendant's active military status.

You, the Plaintiff, arrange to serve the Declaration of Default, Identification and Active Military Service with all of the other documents listed on page 3.

<b>Top of Form (Caption):</b> Fill in the caption exactly as you filled in the caption on the <i>Summons</i> .
Fill in your full legal name. This should match your name in the Caption.
Paragraph 1: Read carefully. If this information isn't correct, you can't use this form.
Paragraph 2: Review your answer to Paragraph 3b of your Form 3: Brief.
Check (✓) the first box if you checked (✓) the first box of Paragraph 3b of your Form 3: Brief. Fill in all of the information for the Defendant. If you don't know the Defendant's occupation or employer's name or address, write "Unknown" in the appropriate space.
