

Under N.D.R.App.P. 4(b)(1), an appeal in a criminal matter must be filed within 30 days after entry of the order or judgment. An extension of 30 days can be granted. However, the notice of appeal was filed outside the original time and outside the time for any extension. This Court has no jurisdiction to review an order based on an untimely filed notice of appeal.

The matter was referred to the Chief Justice, who did not authorize me to file the document. The notice of appeal has not been filed and no action will be taken on it.


