Dear Ms. Miller:

Since I believe information I will provide today applies to functions of Courts that are under the authority of the North Dakota Supreme Court (Supreme Court) whether or not proposed changes to Administrative Rule 41 occurs, I believe it is important to provide certain information to show how a person can be harmed by listing only the index of a court case online and by not making all records available for review online.

However, to provide this information, I will need to provide background information first. This includes the results of corruption by the City of Mandan (City) and its influence over the Mandan Police Department (MPD) that results in harm to the innocent while the City and the MPD act in ways that should be considered unlawful under the North Dakota Century Code (N.D.C.C.) in addition to violate the state and federal constitutional rights of the innocent.

Neither my wife nor I were from North Dakota nor from Mandan when we bought our home in the winter when snow and ice blocked us from seeing that City infrastructure like streets, curbs and sidewalks had not been maintained by the City. In fact, streets were worn out and degraded from decades of heavy traffic, to include from heavy school buses, regarding the nearby school that was no longer used as a school but yet the damage to the streets remained.

Curbing in many areas had degraded, to include by repeated damage from City contracted snow removal each year, to the point that curbing around properties like ours no longer existed and I have to stand in the street to try to hold a lawnmower up while I mow parts of the boulevards. A large area of one sidewalk near our home is also very damaged and it caused my wife to fall one of the times she mowed before I moved the remainder of our belongings to Mandan.

After the weather warmed, we also found that the City, including the MPD, had abandon our neighborhood when it came to enforcing state laws and City ordinances to the point that crime and other unsafe conditions is a serious problem. As I am not a North Dakotan, I do not think like many North Dakotans and, as a veteran, I spoke up and I spoke out about the neglect to the point that I requested records from the City while I reported code violations to the MPD.

In doing this, I received an email from City Administrator Jim Neubauer on June 24, 2013, when he admitted to problems in our neighborhood that included: *"The home you purchased is in an older part of town... and in many areas and over the years the curb in this area has deteriorated to a point of nonexistence....In this area of town we understand the streets, water lines, sanitary sewer and storm sewer lines are aged and in need of repair or replacement."*

City Administrator Neubauer also stated: *"I would suggest you hang on for a few years and see how a project might progress in this area."* When I discussed that and other statements by City Administrator Neubauer with longtime residents of Mandan, they laughed, they said nothing at all would be done and that the practice of the City is to lie to try to avoid issues while putting issues off as long as possible by lying to make residents believe that something would be done.

Nearly a year later, after the City still had not repaired the sidewalk near our property and as our neighborhood continued to decline while other areas in Mandan with far better streets had streets repaved as streets in our neighborhood continued to degrade, I contacted the City again about the failure of the City to maintain City infrastructure in our neighborhood while I made requests for records to try to find out what the truth really was.

This produced a letter of response from City Administrator Neubauer dated May 21, 2014, which was sent to me as a PDF file attached to an email. Provided a copy of Page 9 from that letter and I have provided it because of these statements in Item 24: *“Much of the residential areas just north of downtown are very much in need of work...The engineering department in coordination with public works does however plan to tackle these street projects within the next 5 years.”*

Yet, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017 went by with the sidewalk near our property still in disrepair as streets in our neighborhood continued to degrade while other areas in Mandan with far better streets had those streets repaved. As such, I was forced to use United States (U.S.) mail at my expense to submit a request for records to City Administrator Neubauer because I believed that any email I sent to any publicly funded City email address would be both unconstitutionally and unlawfully blocked by the City.

My request for records was dated August 9, 2017, and a copy is provided but City Administrator Neubauer committed criminal acts under N.D.C.C. § 44-04-21.3 and N.D.C.C. § 12.1-11-06 by violating N.D.C.C. § 44-04-18 by not releasing the records I requested and by not providing the required written notification stating either that the records did not exist or a legal authority used to withhold the records. Of course, if no records existed, this would show that longtime residents were right and that I was lied to by City Administrator Neubauer because the City has no plans to repair and replace infrastructure in our neighborhood that the City is responsible for maintaining.

When I received no response by September 4, 2017, I was again forced to use U.S. mail at my expense to contact City Administrator Neubauer because I believed that any email I sent to any publicly funded City email address would be both unconstitutionally and unlawfully blocked by the City. A copy of that letter is provided and I reminded City Administrator Neubauer that the records I requested on dated August 9, 2017, still needed to be released.

However, I also included a request for records in my letter to City Administrator Neubauer dated September 4, 2017, but City Administrator Neubauer committed criminal acts under N.D.C.C. § 44-04-21.3 and N.D.C.C. § 12.1-11-06 by violating N.D.C.C. § 44-04-18 by not releasing the records I requested and by not providing the required written notification stating either that the records did not exist or a legal authority used to withhold the records.

This is yet another form of censorship by the City, by withholding records to hide the truth from the people; just as the City unlawfully and unconstitutionally blocked emails from those the City neither wants to hear from nor will release records to that would expose the truth. When this type and level of corruption permeates in government, the people have lost their voice, their right to be heard, and the rights granted to them statutorily and constitutionally.

The City has yet to establish rules in print for speaking a public meetings and if a resident tries to question the City during a public meeting, they may be quickly silenced and event threatened by the City with removal from the public meeting as part of a practice of censorship that is prevalent in Mandan.

Provided is a copy of a letter that I obtained from the North Dakota Office of Attorney General (OAG), which I obtained by making a request for records since the OAG continues to refuse to put requests for formal opinions made under N.D.C.C. § 44-04-21.1 available online for review because putting those requests online would show how Attorney General Wayne Stenehjem lied within the formal opinions he issued and how he failed to address all violations alleged since the intent by the OAG is to protect certain public entities at the expense of the people.

In the letter to the OAG from the Mandan resident, the following was stated: *“I have enclosed the Public Notice that was printed in the paper and the Public Notice that appeared in city halls, also a recording of the hearing. At this hearing, Mayor Lamont asked Police Chief Rohr to remove me from the meeting and or make me sit down. Police Chief Rohr had his hand on my elbow trying to get me to comply with Mayor Lamont’s request...I was too intimidated to get back up and speak after the meeting came back into session.”*

People who might have thought about speaking at a City Commission meeting but either saw or heard what that Mandan resident was subjected to were no longer willing to speak up. And, if a Mandan resident was still willing to report unlawful activity or code violations, the practices of the MPD was to tell the suspects who reported them so those that did the reporting suffered acts of retaliation as another way to cause censorship by dissuading residents to not report anything.

When I refused to be dissuaded and parts of Mandan continued to decline, the MPD increased the threats against those that reported unlawful activity or code violations by accessing databases to obtain additional information to put in police reports on those that reported unlawful activity or code violations when the MPD did not do the same for those that were reported or for property owners responsible for code violations. That information was then given to the suspects/property owners to subject those that made the reports to even worse acts of retaliation.

This is exactly what happened to me when I reported code violations at a property that turned out to be owned by Craig Alan Haug and Kristin Haug before I knew that Craig Alan Haug was the brother to Lt. Patrick Bryan Haug with the MPD and before I knew that Kristin Haug worked for the City funded Mandan Progress Organization located inside a City building.

Provided is a copy of the police report, which I redacted, containing my full legal name and also a plethora of personal information on me that I did not provide the MPD but which the MPD was able to obtain from other sources to include on me in the police report when I was only the person reporting the code violations at the property owned by Craig Alan Haug and Kristin Haug. Yet, not even the name of Kristin Haug appeared despite her having both equal ownership of the property and equal responsibility for the code violations that were confirmed by the MPD.

This demonstrated obvious bias and unequal treatment by the MPD and so did the fact that the only information included on Craig Alan Haug was only his name in the Officer Notes and then it was not his full legal name as was used on me even though Craig Alan Haug was both an equal ownership of the property and equally responsibility for the code violations.

I have also provided a copy of the Official Notice issued by the MPD, upon confirming that code violations were present but the name of Kristin Haug was again not included even though she is both an equal owner of that property with the code violations and equally responsible for code violations that were confirmed by the MPD as present at that property. This was also evidence of bias and unequal treatment by the MPD, which I have been repeatedly subjected to by both the MPD and the City as a whole.

Within a day of the police report and the Official Notice, Craig Alan Haug stalked and harassed my wife and I as we were walking our deaf and blind dog; which was followed that day by Craig Alan Haug getting out of his car and standing in the street while shouting strange statements due to my having reported code violations to the MPD. Such conduct also revealed that Craig Alan Haug was informed that I reported the code violations, which was the practice of the MPD as a way to subject those that report code violations to acts of retaliation.

Over the next six months, Craig Alan Haug found different ways to stalk and harass me; as he changed his method each time I contacted the MPD about his stalking and harassment, yet the MPD never wrote even one police report but my contacting the MPD the four time did put in end to the stalking and harassment.

However, what did not end were the criminal acts of vandalism to my wife' SUV that included puncturing the side of one tire, tampering with lug nuts on one wheel, a profanity-laced note left on her SUV, pouring water in the gas tank, using a type of glue in the locking gas cap added to her SUV and then her SUV was egged. I have provided a PDF file containing a scanned image of that profanity-laced note; a note directed at me, given that I am a veteran with veteran license plates on my SUV.

And, even our deaf and blind dog was targeted with a large amount of a putrid and foul-smelling substance thrown on the back walkway to our home that I used to take our dog for a walk three times a day; which may have also contained a poisonous substance. That was followed by three large pieces of cooked meat left on the two boulevards next to our property where I walked our dog three times a day and we do not know if the pieces of meat were poisonous in some way.

I expressed concerns to the OAG that the MPD obtained information on me other than from me and that MPD released that information, and other information on me, to suspects even though the information was considered exempt under N.D.C.C. § 44-04-18.7 and N.D.C.C. § 44-04-18.21 was being released to suspects. I would be informed by the OAG that the MPD gather any information on outside sources on anyone at its discretion and that the MPD had the discretion under N.D.C.C. § 44-04-17.1(5) to release exempt information at any time and to anyone

What this has to do with having access to court records will be explained in my next letter but it was important to provide this information for clarity and to put everything in context.

Good Afternoon Mr. Jordan,

The home you purchased is in an older part of town...obviously not telling you something you don't already know, and in many areas and over the years the curb in this area has deteriorated to a point of nonexistence. When a street maintenance project moves through an area of town, generally the curb and out of compliance sidewalks are repaired as part of the road project.

In this area of town we understand the streets, water lines, sanitary sewer and storm sewer lines are aged and in need of repair or replacement. The issue is the affordability to the homeowners. I wish I could give you a date (year) in when those repairs will occur, but at this time we are in the early stages of trying to put together a project. If a homeowner wishes to repair the curb in front of their home they would need a permit from the City to do so. And within 0-10 years a project in this area may occur, the replaced curbing torn out at no reimbursement to the homeowner.

I would suggest you hang on for a few years and see how a project might progress in this area.

I did notice a sidewalk that looked like it went from the middle of the block or your front door, to the street. As someone who lived in this area up until a few years ago, had the same type of sidewalk and I simply removed the walkway and planted grass. (view 1)

Mr. Neubauer:

More than four (4) years ago, on June 24, 2013, I received an email from you and a copy of that email is provided with this letter. When I told longtime residents in our neighborhood exactly what you stated to me, I was told that you had just lied to me, that the City of Mandan (City) has neglected our neighborhood for decades and that you knew when you sent your email that what you stated in it was false. That is why the same residents told me that nothing would be done to replace any of the dilapidated streets or the degraded curbing in our neighborhood.

What you stated in your email included "The home you purchased is in an older [City neglected] part of town...When a street maintenance project moves through an area of town, generally the curb and out of compliance sidewalks are repaired as part of the road project. In this area of town we understand the streets, water lines, sanitary sewer and storm sewer lines are aged and in need of repair or replacement. The issue is the affordability to the homeowners. I wish I could give you a date (year) in when those repairs will occur, but at this time we are in the early stages of trying to put together a project...within 0-10 years a project in this area may occur...I would suggest you hang on for a few years and see how a project might progress in this area."

Frankly, what I was told by residents was that you were knowingly lying to me, that no project would occur in our neighborhood and that your telling me to "hang on for a few years" was your way of lying to me to put me off for a few years while I was left waiting to see what the City would do when there would not be any plans to do anything in our neighborhood.

Now, this year, I see that neighborhoods having newer streets than what we have, which includes streets in other neighborhoods repaved well after our streets were and streets having gutters too that streets in our neighborhood still do not have, are receiving repair work and repaving while our neighborhood continues to be neglected even though some of our streets are dilapidated due to wear and tear from school buses that went to and from the old school on 4th Street NW and where 3rd Street NW still incurs additional wear and tear from school buses using our street to take students to and from the private St. Joseph's Catholic School located on Collins Avenue.

In addition to this, the City, by not repairing the curbing, creates hazardous conditions for many residents in our neighborhood who have to stand in the street to try to hold their lawnmowers on the boulevards because needed curbing is missing to place lawnmower wheels on and rocks from the degraded curbing are thrown onto the boulevards by vehicles; making it hazardous to be near the streets in case a loose rock is thrown up by a vehicle and when the blade of a lawnmower can hit the loose rocks on the boulevards.

I see this as a case of 'the haves and the have nots' because the City not only continues to neglect our neighborhood but knowingly contributes to that neglect, causing a continuous decline of our neighborhood, by not proactively enforcing state laws and City ordinances in our neighborhood; while the reactive enforcement is almost as pathetic, which may require legal actions to get the City to finally do what our taxes pay for.

You stood inside the old school on August 28, 2016, and did not appear to have any problems at that time lying to the residents that were present but yet you became silent, and said nothing, in response to one resident asking you what the City was going to do to stop the continued decline of our neighborhood when that resident told you that our neighborhood has declined each of the seventeen (17) years that resident has lived in our neighborhood. And, while such a decline has been occurring in our neighborhood, the City may have spent millions just to keep the Mandan Progress Organization solvent at the expense of our neighborhood.

Since I believe you lied to me in your email from June 24, 2013, because I do not believe that the City has any plans in place to replace our dilapidated streets and degraded curbing, I request a copy of the necessary City records showing what plans the City currently has in place to replace our dilapidated streets and degraded curbing


I request that all records be released in the most expedite way possible and in an electronic format if available; to include as PDF files attached to emails.




Dear Attorney General Wayne Stenehjem:

I am requesting an opinion regarding an alleged violation of the state's open meetings laws.

I have enclosed the Press Release received from the City of Mandan's Website. On February 6 after the regular city commission meeting, the city commission went into an executive decision, according to this Press Release the city decided during this executive decision meeting to purchase to buildings. All other buildings that have been purchased relating to the diesel spill remediation effort have been during a public hearing, not behind close doors. I understand that this was to avoid continuing the process of eminent domain proceedings, but the one building, is Mandan's oldest building downtown, and is part of the National Register of Historic Places listed in our Historic District. The demolition appears to have already started. I am not sure if the State Historical Society has had the opportunity to tour the building and document whatever they may want or if they were even informed of demolition. Because there was not public meeting held, there has not been an opportunity for the Historical and Preservation Groups to ask permission to enter the premises or to be informed of what the city's plan for these historic properties. Was their any violation in the open meeting laws with any part of this decision being discussed in executive session versus given notice at held during an open city commission meeting?

I am awaiting your opinion on the meeting January 30 on the issue of being threatened to be removed by the Police Chief and being intimidated to prevent participating in a comment session of a public hearing.
