[¶1] On February 5, 2021, Sharon Parisien-Strong filed a notice of appeal from a district court judgment entered on December 8, 2020. On April 6, 2021, Parisien-Strong filed a motion to extend the time to file the Appellant’s brief, which was granted. On May 12, 2021, Parisien-Strong filed a second motion to extend the time to file the Appellant’s brief, which was also granted. The Appellant’s brief was due May 31, 2021, but it was not received. By letter dated June 2, 2021, Parisien-Strong was notified that unless she filed an affidavit no later than 4 p.m. on June 10, 2021, showing good cause why this action should not be dismissed, the matter will be referred to the Court for authority to issue an Order dismissing the appeal.
