MOTION FOR RELIEF TO FILE IN EXCESS OF PAGE LIMITATION

[¶1] Petitioners, by and through counsel, move pursuant to Rule 27 of the North Dakota Rules of Appellate Procedure, for an Order of the North Dakota Supreme Court granting relief from the twelve-page limitation typically imposed for the Petitioners' Reply brief. Petitioners are attempting to accurately cite and respond to the newly produced record below in support of their Petition and to provide to the Court support for their legal position. Given the atypical procedural posture, compliance with the page limitation will prejudice Petitioner's ability to respond to both the Findings of Fact and the Respondent's brief within the typical twelve-page limit. Despite good-faith efficiency, Petitioners cannot adequately present their response to the District Court's Findings of Fact and the Respondent's Response brief in compliance with the typical twelve-page limitation set forth in Rule 32(a)(8)(A). Accordingly, Petitioners respectfully request leave to file their brief with an additional eighteen pages, no more than thirty pages in total.

[¶2] Petitioners reached out to and conferred multiple times with Respondent beginning on Friday, August 26, 2022, and continuing through weekend, but Respondent was unable to consent or provide a definitive position. Because of the exigencies of time and the need to prepare a brief as quickly as possible and without further delay, Petitioners now file this motion.


